Associates

- **Legislative processes**

Continuous updates on regulatory developments and relevant initiatives. We represent the interest of our associates by translating it into legislative, policy and regulatory action.

- **ENTRA Events**

How to join: Associate

EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

Organisations or companies interested in joining ENTRA express their motivations in a letter addressed to the members, together with an explanation of their activities. Members have a period of five days to submit justified allegations to the entry of the new associate and, if there are any, the Board of Directors will resolve them.

MEMBERSHIP FEE

The **membership fee to join ENTRA** as an associate is 10.000 euros, adjusted proportionally to the date of entry.

WITHDRAWAL FROM THE ASSOCIATION

The application for withdrawal from ENTRA can be made at any time before September of the current year.



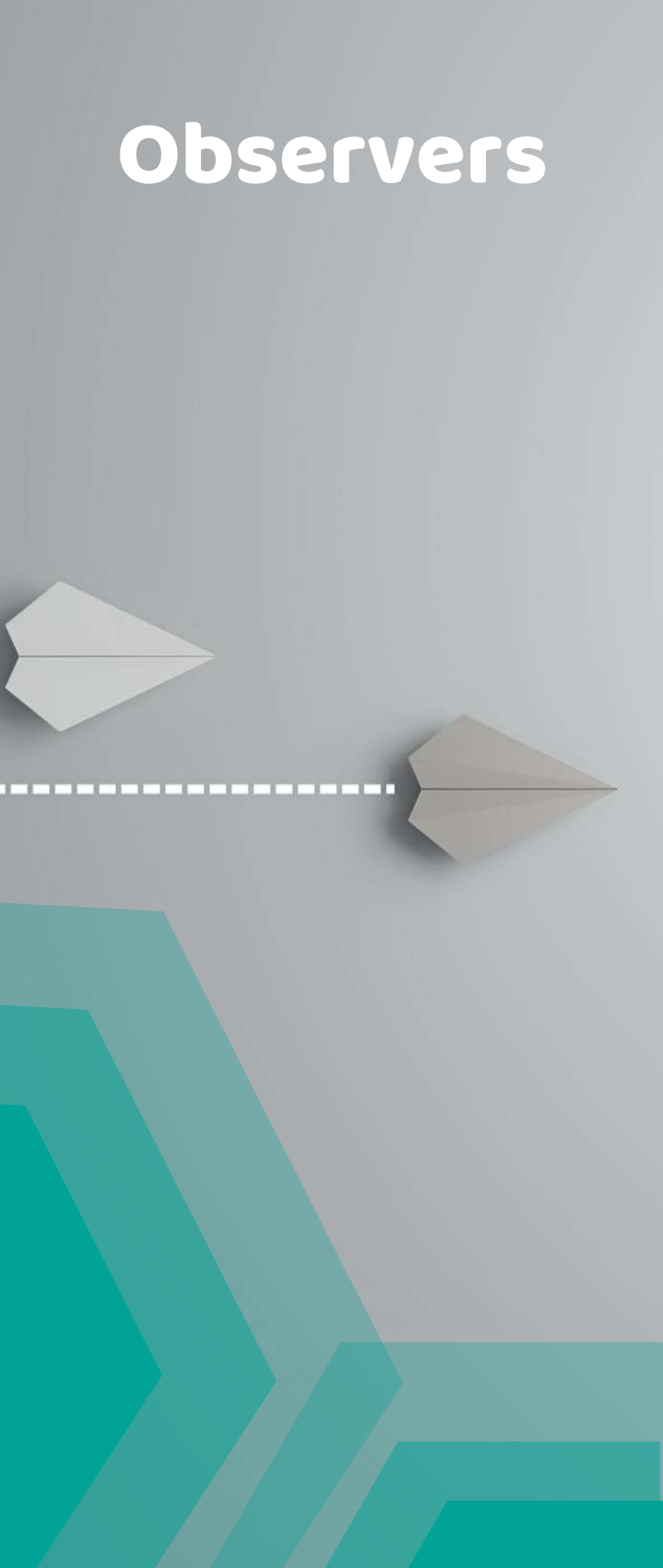

EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

To join ENTRA as an Observer, simply submit a written application and sign the membership agreement.

OBSERVER MEMBERSHIP FEE

The **fee to join ENTRA as an Observer** is 3,000 euros, adjusted proportionally to the date of entry.

WITHDRAWAL FROM THE ASSOCIATION

The application to leave ENTRA can be made at any time, but always before September of the current year.

MONTHLY MEETINGS

They take place on the **first Wednesday of the month** in an online format. The Executive Management presents regulatory developments, consultations and other matters of interest.

GENERAL ASSEMBLY

An **annual General Assembly** is held. In the month in which the meeting is held, it replaces the monthly meeting.

ONE-TO-ONE MEETINGS

Two one-to-one meetings are held with each Member per year, as well as a welcome meeting.
